#### Workshop Selection Process

There is limited space for workshops at the TxABA conference. The TxABA Program Committee will review all workshop submissions and make selections. Please complete the Survey Monkey questionnaire, which includes uploading your CV, bio, and headhsot. If you wish to submit more than one workshop, each workshop requires its own Survey Monkey questionnaire.

#### Timeline

Call for proposals – September 4, 2024 Submission deadline – October 9, 2024 Program committee review – October 2024 Notification to Selected Presenters by November 1, 2024 Workshop Registration opens in November 2024 Registration will remain open until the workshop reaches capacity \*TxABA will send monthly updates of workshop registrants \*TxABA will communicate with workshop instructor as we get closer regarding keeping registration open to the conference and if on-site registration is feasible due to materials

#### Cancellation

In early March 2025 TxABA will communicate with instructors how many individuals have registered for the workshop. At that point in time the instructor or TxABA may determine to cancel the workshop if less than 10 individuals have registered.

#### Materials

Instructors are responsible for providing materials to attendees. TxABA recommends that materials be provided electronically to attendees two weeks prior to the workshop. TxABA will provide the workshop instructor with the email addresses of individuals who have registered.

#### Workshop Room

Workshop rooms will have standard presentation equipment including screen and projector. TxABA is contracting with the hotel/BL to provide AV equipment. Instructors are responsible for bringing their own computer.



#### Workshop Instructor Payment Formula

Registration for TxABA Members is \$80 for 3-hour workshops and \$150 for 6-hour workshops. Non-Members registration is \$120 for 3-hour workshops and \$225 for 6-hour workshops. TxABA will pay the workshop instructor 40% of each non-refunded workshop registration fee. Cancellations and refunds will follow TxABA's general policies <u>https://txaba.org/terms/</u>

For example, if there were 15 members ( $15 \times 80 = 1,200$ ) and 2 nonmembers ( $2 \times 120 = 240$ ) who registered and paid for a 3-hour workshop then TxABA would pay \$576 to the workshop instructor (1200+240) x 0.4 = 576).
