BCBA Clinical Supervisors are responsible for oversight & leadership of their team of technicians & clients. Services are provided both in clinic & in the community. Services include assessment of language, self-care, social skills, academics, behavior function, vocational skills, etc.; development, implementation, evaluation, & monitoring of behavior intervention plans; development & updating of treatment objectives; consultation to schools & families; & staff/family training. Client challenges include lack of functional skills & problem behaviors.

The position is primarily M thru F 8-5 with some flexibility.
